THE W. TURRENTINE-JACKSON PRIZE

The Western History Association announces the competition for the biennial W. Turrentine Jackson Award. The award will be presented to a beginning professional historian for **a first book on any aspect of the history of the American West**. Presses may submit more than one book. The winner of the \$1,000 award will be announced during the Western History Association's annual conference. Presses should send a letter of nomination and a copy of the book to each member of the award committee (see below).

To be eligible for the award in 2013, the book must have been published in 2011 or 2012.

Materials must be submitted to all three committee members to be considered. All submission materials must be *received* by the deadline.
