THE DAVID J. WEBER-CLEMENTS PRIZE

The WHA announces the David J. Weber-Clements Prize given annually for the **best non-fiction book on Southwestern America**.

The competition will be open to any non-fiction book, including biography, on any aspect of Southwestern life, past or present, with a 2011 copyright. The purpose of the prize is to promote fine writing and original research on the American Southwest. The author will receive \$2,500 and an invitation to give the annual Weber-Clements Prize Lecture at Southern Methodist University.

Materials must be submitted to all committee members to be considered. All submission materials must be *received* by the deadline.
